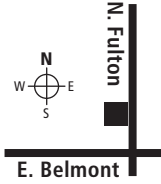
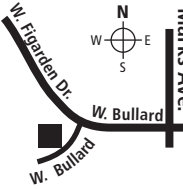

Sexual Addiction Test

- Were you sexually abused as a child or adolescent?
- Have sexual thoughts interfered with your ability to function at work or at school?
- Do you fail to meet commitments or fail to carry out responsibilities because of your involvement with pornography?
- Have you had sex regardless of the consequences, the threat of being caught, the risk of contracting herpes, gonorrhea, AIDS, etc.?
- Have you had sex at inappropriate times, in inappropriate places, and/or with inappropriate people?
- Have you had an important relationship end because of your inability to stop looking at pornography and/or outside sexual activity?
- Have you increased the risk you take online (giving out your name and phone number, meeting people offline, etc.)?
- Confused about your sexual identity?
- The spouse or parent of someone who is struggling with these issues?
- A Christian leader searching for resources?

Making decisions about sex can be difficult, but dealing with everything that comes with it can be downright frightening.
