HOPE Sanger is a multi-denominational non-profit community outreach program established to provide food and other necessities to the homeless and poor of Sanger.

It was founded in October of 2010 by Julie Mendoza, who, in the words of Christian songwriter Josh Wilson, "refused to sit around and wait for someone else to do what God had called her to do."

The organization has several Sanger community churches involved at the present working together without any religious agendas to serve the homeless and the neediest of the Sanger community.

Initially, the organization focused on preparing and delivering meals every Saturday to the homeless and others in need.

After inquiring about those people's needs in addition to food, the effort was expanded to provide other basic necessities such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, soap, deodorant, sanitary napkins, diapers, bicycle parts, and other essential items depending on the season.

November 13, 2010 was the first cook and food delivery and since that date the organization has consistently united each Saturday since then to continue the work of service to those in need.

It is with great love, care and faith that the volunteers gather in. We strive to inform, and provide resources, to listen to them and direct them to make better choices for themselves.

How are we funded?
Primarily through private donations from individuals, churches, businesses and community organizations.

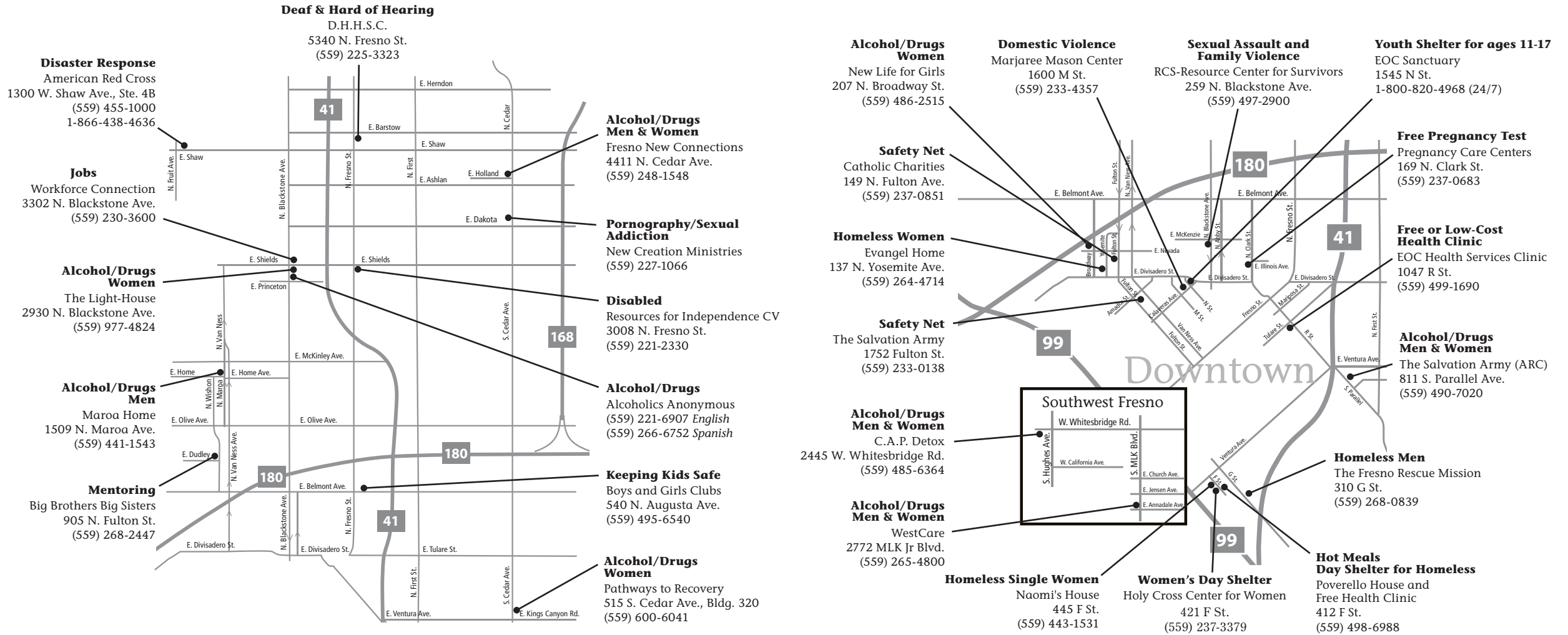


If you are homeless, living on the streets, park, motel or doubled up with family or friends, you qualify to be "served."
